**CONDITIONAL RELEASE – NO CONTACT ORDER**

New  This Order replaces all earlier Conditional Release Orders in the cases noted above.

Post Bail/Bond in the amount \$ 500,000 without conditions, except to appear at all court appearances..


TO THE DEFENDANT: Unless you post the full bail/bond noted above, you will be released from custody upon the following marked conditions. Failure to comply with any condition may result in your arrest and imposition of the bond indicated above or on the original Complaint

1.  You are released on your personal recognizance; no bail required.
2.  Remain in the care and supervision of \_\_\_\_\_ which/who has agreed to supervise you.
3.  Post Bail/Bond in the amount of \$ 400,000 , or a cash alternative of \$ \_\_\_\_\_
4.  Do not have direct or indirect contact (including through text and social media) with officer Hammitz  MALE  FEMALE
5.  Stay away from a three-block radius of \_\_\_\_\_  
except with a police escort to recover prescription medications, personal clothing, toiletries, and \_\_\_\_\_
6.  Curfew: Remain in your residence between the hours of \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ except as may be required for work or school.
7.  Geographic restrictions: Do not enter \_\_\_\_\_
8.  Do not have parenting time with \_\_\_\_\_  
unless authorized by a Family Court Order or Juvenile Court Order issued after this date and a copy of that Order is in your possession.
9.  Do not possess a firearm or ammunition. (It is a crime for any person charged with a felony, convicted of a crime of violence, convicted of a domestic assault, or subject to an order for protection to possess a firearm [or ammunition], 18 U.S.C. §922(g) and (n))
10.  Remain law abiding; do not commit any criminal offense.
11.  Make all court appearances.
12.  Other (not supervised by Probation): Surrender passport to Probation
13.  Pursuant to the Hennepin County mental health pre-trial release initiative, complete an in-custody Mental Health Diagnostic Assessment. If eligible, you may be released to a program determined by HSPHD when space is available and without having to post the conditional release bond/bail noted above.


**The following marked conditions require supervision by Probation (612-348-7001).**

14.  Your Conditional Release will be actively supervised by a Conditional Release Officer. You must obey all conditions imposed by your Conditional Release Officer. Your Conditional Release Officer may require phone contact, in-person contact, and/or home visits.
15.  Notify your Conditional Release Officer of an address change within 24 hrs. Do not leave the State of Minn without approval by the Court.
16.  Do not use  alcohol or  non-prescribed mood-altering substances. Take all prescribed medication as directed; sign releases to allow your Conditional Release Officer to confirm your prescriptions. You are subject to (select one):  
 Random testing  Remote Electronic Alcohol Monitoring at your expense.
17.  Complete a chemical dependency assessment and follow recommendations. Your assessment interview  may be done out of custody, if done within 96 hours of your release, or  must be completed in custody. If the assessment is done in custody, you are to be released:  
 upon completion of the assessment interview  to the recommended treatment program without the need to post bail/bond  
 only upon further court order.
18.  If eligible, you must remain on Electronic Home Monitoring (EHM) and to follow EHM rules.  
 You will remain in custody and be transported by the DOCCR to activate EHM.  
 You must report on \_\_\_\_\_ p.m. \_\_\_\_\_ as directed by your Conditional Release Officer to activate EHM.
