

# Fast Facts – MyMNGuardian (MMG)

## What is MyMNGuardian (MMG)?

MMG is an online application developed by the MN Judicial Branch that allows court-appointed guardians or their attorneys to submit Personal Well-Being Reports and the corresponding Affidavits of Service electronically.

## How can I learn to use MMG?

Find training resources on the [Judicial Branch’s MyMNGuardian page](#) as follows:

1. Type <https://www.mncourts.gov/> in your internet browser.
2. Select **Help Topics** in the top menu (smartphone users may have to select the menu icon ).
3. Select the **MyMNGuardian** topic.
4. Select the **Training** tab.

## How do I access MMG?

Access MMG by going to <https://mmg.courts.state.mn.us/>, or by scanning the following QRC with your phone’s camera:



The first time you access MMG you will need to create a MyCourtMN account. For instructions, go to the [MyMNGuardian page](#) and click on the **Set Up an Account** tab.

## Why was MMG created?

MMG encourages timely filings by sending reminder notifications to guardians for things such as report due dates. The system also keeps a history of the reports you have filed through MMG each year.

## Do I have to use MMG?

Yes. As of on **April 15, 2024**, all court-appointed guardians or their attorneys must use MMG to file annual Personal Well-Being Reports and Affidavits of Service. On October 12, 2023, the Minnesota Supreme Court issued an order making the use of MMG mandatory for all court-appointed guardians in Minnesota.

## Do I have to use a desktop computer?

No. MMG is a smartphone-friendly application that can be used on any smart device with access to the internet, such as a smart phone or tablet.
