



2024 CRIMINAL EXPUNGEMENT CLINIC – FREE

Expungement is the process of going to court to ask a judge to seal a court record. People request an expungement when they have been denied a job, housing, or a professional license because of a criminal incident that shows up on a background check.

Attend an informational session and see if you qualify financially to meet individually with an attorney regarding whether this is a realistic option for your situation. No pre-registration is necessary. This is the best place to start the process for criminal expungement and get assistance with the process. Sessions will take place in the Law Library. **Sessions start at 1:30 p.m. Please arrive by 1 p.m. Late arrival may prevent an individual meeting with attorney.**

Court forms will be provided to all registrants, or they can be picked up at the Law Library for free.
