**ORDER FOR MEDIATION REGARDING
MOTION TO AMEND PROTOCOLS**

The above entitled matter came on before the Court without a hearing upon the Court's review of the Motion to Amend Protocols filed August 6, 2021; the Motion to Enforce Existing Court Ordered Protocols on Communications and Establish Protocols on Communications to Future Transition filed August 10, 2021; and the Motion to Institute Protocols to Facilitate Closure of the Estate filed August 13, 2021; all filed on behalf of Heirs Sharon Nelson, Norrine Nelson and John Nelson, as well as L. Londell McMillan and Charles Spicer. The moving parties seek various orders regarding Estate protocols and access to information.

In the Order Regarding L. Londell McMillan and Charles Spicer's Rights as Interested Persons Under Minnesota Statute § 524.1-201(33) filed May 3, 2021, this Court ordered that the parties address informally or, if necessary, mediate any issues with regards to information sharing protocols. Therefore, the Court makes the following:

ORDER

1. The parties shall mediate the issues raised in the Motion to Amend Protocols filed August 6, 2021; the Motion to Enforce Existing Court Ordered Protocols on Communications and Establish Protocols on Communications to Future Transition filed August 10, 2021; and the Motion to Institute Protocols to Facilitate Closure of the Estate filed August 13, 2021. Unless otherwise mutually agreed, mediation shall be scheduled to take place by no later than November 30, 2021.

2. If the parties are unable to reach an agreement at mediation, the Court will issue an order for further submissions and thereafter take the matters under advisement.
