The following report contains information on Mohamed Noor's progress at the [REDACTED] State Penitentiary.

Institutional Adjustment:

Mr. Noor arrived at [REDACTED] on 7/11/19. Upon his arrival, he expressed some concern over being housed in our general population areas due to the highly promoted nature of his crime. We were able to hire him as a permanent worker in our [REDACTED] Unit after he successfully completed our orientation process. This allowed him to remain in an environment that he felt comfortable in and has allowed me to remain his Case Manager for his stay in our facility thus far. He has adapted to our system very well – he has no concerns about his safety and interacted exceptionally well with staff and other residents.

Work Assignment:

Mr. Noor works in our Clerk position within the [REDACTED] Unit. He began working as our janitor and accepted this position with more responsibility when the job became available. He assists our staff with necessary paperwork for admitting new arrivals, prepares the items that are issued to every new arrival, and assists other permanent workers as needed or when asked without hesitation. He has also been a tremendous asset to the new arrivals as well – he shares his experiences with the facility that helps ease the minds of others that have never been incarcerated before.

Treatment Involvement:

Mr. Noor has no treatment recommendations to participate in or complete while in our facility.





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Educational/Vocational Programs:

Mr. Noor has no educational requirements to complete while within our facility.

Disciplinary Reports:

Since arriving at [REDACTED], Mr. Noor has received no incident reports of any kind. He has earned 14 positive behavior reports for demonstrating pro-social behavior, going above and beyond in his job duties, and his willingness to help staff and other residents. He has displayed an excellent ability to be a positive role model to residents and staff alike.

Health:

Mr. Noor has no medical issues or needs at this time.
