SCHEDULING ORDER

1. Trial will commence on Monday, March 7, 2022 at 9:00 a.m. The Court will hear any motions *in limine* or administrative matters on March 7 and jury selection will begin on Tuesday, March 8, 2022 at 9:00 a.m. Opening statements and witness testimony will begin on Monday, March 28, 2022 at 9:00 a.m.
2. Motions *in limine* shall be filed by the end of the day on Friday, February 4, 2022. Supporting memoranda shall be filed by the end of the day on Friday, February 11, 2022 and any responsive memoranda shall be filed by the end of the day on Friday, February 25, 2022.
3. The parties shall exchange trial witness lists by the end of the day on Friday, February 4, 2022.
4. The parties shall exchange trial exhibit lists by the end of the day on Friday, March 4, 2022. All exhibits shall be pre-marked as "Exhibit #####" and listed on the exhibit list with a short, general description (e.g. photo of scene). The State shall use exhibit numbers 1-1000.

Defendant Thao shall use exhibit numbers 2001-3000. Defendant Lane shall use exhibit numbers 3001-4000. Defendant Kueng shall use exhibit numbers 4001-5000.

5. Proposed jury instructions shall be filed by the end of the day on Friday, March 4, 2022.
6. The parties shall submit proposed alterations to the jury questionnaire used in *State v. Chauvin* by the end of the day on Monday, September 17, 2021.
7. If any party intends to disclose expert witnesses other than those already disclosed, they shall serve the experts' names, *curricula vitae*, expert reports and findings, and complete written summaries of the subject matter of each expert's testimony by December 15, 2021. Disclosures must include all findings, opinions, and conclusions to which they are expected to testify, the basis for the findings, opinions and conclusions, and each expert's qualifications if not already evident from the *curriculum vitae*.
