

counsel for Petitioners, the Respondent Secretary of State's Office, and counsel for Intervenor-Respondents. I attach as Exhibit B a copy of a December 24, 2008 email from Mr. Gelbmann enclosing the Protocol and thanking the parties for their agreement on the document.

3. Pursuant to the Protocol, local election officials initially identified 1,342 absentee ballot envelopes they believe to have been improperly rejected. Based on information provided under earlier Data Privacy Act requests, Petitioners agree that 778 of these ballots indeed were improperly rejected. We will need to review the applications and other supporting materials provided by officials at regional meetings before determining whether we can agree that any of the remaining 564 ballots were improperly rejected.

4. From the information previously provided by county officials, and pursuant to Paragraph 11 of the Protocol, Petitioners identified an additional 654 absentee ballots that may have been improperly rejected. A list of those is attached as Exhibit C. From the face of the ballot envelopes themselves, it appears that at least 67 of these were in fact improperly rejected—even though they do not appear on the local election officials' lists referenced in Paragraph 3 above. The remainder require review of ballot applications or registration materials to determine whether they were improperly rejected.

5. On December 29, 2008, Petitioners provided local election officials with the list of these additional absentee ballots and asked that they be included as well in the regional review process set forth in the Protocol.

6. Intervenor-Respondents also identified additional rejected absentee ballots to be reviewed. I attach as Exhibit D a letter from Mr. Lillehaug to the Secretary of State's Office identifying 85 such ballots.

7. Local election officials, and in some instances Intervenor-Respondents, have responded to the identified additional ballots in differing manners—meaning that facially similar ballot envelopes have been treated differently.


8. As examples of how different county officials are responding to the request to include additional absentee ballots, I attach the following:


9. I attach as Exhibit J an outline of relevant events. It has been compiled based on information provided by various sources, and I believe it to be accurate.

10. I attach as Exhibit K a December 31, 2008 letter to Messrs. Gelbmann and Lillehaug.

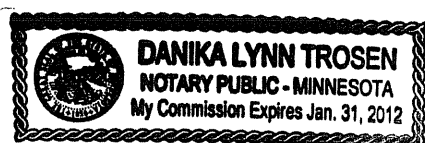

Processing Improperly Rejected Absentee Ballots for US Senator

As directed by the State Supreme Court, the following process is established to ensure for the proper inclusion of wrongly rejected absentee ballots into county canvassing reports.

1. The Supreme Court has ordered that local elected officials must identify all wrongly rejected absentee ballots for consideration by candidate representatives. Under Minnesota law all absentee ballots are accepted unless they have been rejected for one or more of four specific reasons outlined in Minnesota statute.
2. Local election officials (county and city where appropriate) will identify wrongly rejected absentee ballots and then create a spreadsheet listing all believed to have been rejected in error. This spreadsheet will be used to ultimately determine the ballots you recommend be opened and counted.
3. Those counties and cities that have already completed a sorting of their rejected Absentee Ballots into five categories should include the ballots placed into the category five for both regular and UOCAVA ballots and should do a review of any other rejected Absentee Ballots that you believe may have been improperly rejected.
4. Those counties that have not completed a sorting of their rejected Absentee Ballots should do this as soon as possible, either in a public or private setting. Under the Supreme Court Order, there is no requirement that this sorting be completed as a public process.
5. All wrongly rejected absentee ballots identified by local election officials will be entered into a spreadsheet that lists the name and address of the voter, the precinct and any information available about why the ballot was rejected. This list entered into the spreadsheet should include every ballot that meets the four requirements outlined in Minn. Stat. Sec. 203B.12, subd. 2, and, for UOCAVA ballots, 203B.24 and 203B.25 and was nonetheless rejected. Local election officials will not be simply relying on the reason stated on the envelope for determining if the ballot was properly rejected. For example, if the reason for rejecting the Absentee Ballot states on the envelope: "voter not registered," local officials will verify whether that the voter was registered or not and provide both campaigns and the office of the Secretary of State with a letter certifying that the voter was registered to vote in that precinct.
 - 5a. For all absentee ballots that the local elected official believes were wrongly rejected, the local elected official will check the pre-registered election day roster and verify the voter did not vote on election day. The local election official will provide both campaigns and the office of the Secretary of State with a letter certifying that they have completed this review of the roster.
6. No one will open any secrecy envelopes or count any ballots during the spreadsheet creation process.
7. As soon as they are completed, and in no case later than 5:00 p.m. on December 24, 2008, these spreadsheets will be emailed to the Secretary of State's Office and to the campaigns at the following addresses:

8. To clearly identify the spreadsheet as the complete list of all wrongly rejected absentee ballots being recommended for opening local election officials will place the following notation in the Subject Heading for the e-mail: "(name of jurisdiction)'s Recommended ABs Pursuant To Court Order."

9. Counties where there are zero wrongly rejected absentee ballots will send an email to the Office of the Secretary of State and to campaigns at the addresses listed above to confirm this by 5:00 p.m. on December 24, 2008. Again, even if a county has already done this, it is important to do this again to verify that a careful review was completed and that there are no obvious errors. Please send emails stating that there are no wrongfully rejected absentee ballots to with the Subject Heading "(name of jurisdiction) Has NO Recommended ABs Pursuant To Court Order."

10. Local election officials will provide copies of the envelopes and application forms to each campaign, if they have not already done so. This is needed prior to 5:00 p.m. on Friday, December 26th so that they can review the lists. **Local election officials shall redact any non-public information included on the applications and/or envelopes.** If a county is unable to provide this information to the campaigns by Friday, December 26th, they should do so as early as possible and be prepared to have the information available for the candidates' representatives to review at the county or regional meeting. Candidate representatives must be able to review absentee ballot applications and/or registration applications regarding mismatching signatures, lack of signatures, mismatching address and other incompleteness. Counties must bring these materials to regional meeting if not provided by Friday, December 26.

11. Prior to 10:00 a.m. on Monday, December 29th, representatives of the two campaigns will work together to review the spreadsheets provided by the local officials and identify, without prejudice:

- a) The Rejected Absentee ballots listed on the spreadsheets that both parties agree were wrongfully rejected. The candidates' representatives will provide the Secretary of State's Office and the local officials with a list of absentee ballots they agree have been wrongfully rejected. These ballots will be forwarded to the Secretary of State's Office by the local election officials for receipt prior to 11:59 p.m. January 2, 2009.
- b) Any additional Rejected Absentee Ballots they would like to add to the list. The candidates' representatives will provide the Secretary of State's Office and the local officials with a list of the additional ballots either candidate's representative wants added to the list of wrongfully-rejected absentee ballots along with a notation whether both candidates' representatives agree the ballot was wrongfully rejected.
- c) The Rejected Absentee ballots on the spreadsheets provided by the local election officials that one or both candidate representatives disagree were wrongfully rejected. The candidates' representatives will provide the Secretary of State's Office and the local officials with a list of the rejected absentee ballots for which one or both candidate

representatives disagree were wrongfully rejected, indicating which candidate representative(s) disagreed the ballot was wrongfully rejected.

- d) Additional materials that will be needed from individual counties to verify one or more absentee ballot was rejected in error. The candidates' representatives will provide the Secretary of State's Office and the local officials with a list of the additional materials that must be available at the county or regional meeting.

12. Candidate representatives agree to rely on the certification by local election officials that a registered voter who had his or her absentee ballot rejected did not vote on election day if the candidates' representatives cannot verify that a voter is registered according to the Secretary of State's database.

13. For non-registered absentee ballot envelopes, the local election official shall verify that the individual was not registered as of October 14, 2008. If the individual did not register prior to that date and the local election official certifies that a voter registration card was found in the Absentee Ballot envelope, Candidates' representatives may reserve the right to question whether that individual voted in person on election-day. The local election official shall bring the election-day roster for that individual's precinct to the county or regional review location identified in paragraphs 16 and 17.

14. At 10:00 a.m. Monday, December 29th, the candidate representatives and representatives from the Office of the Secretary of State's Office will meet in the State Office Building (room to be determined) to discuss rejected absentee ballots that are listed in 11 (b), 11 (c) and 11 (d). The purpose of the meeting will be to attempt to reach consensus on the actual status of the rejected absentee ballots that are included in these categories.

15. By 3:00 p.m. on Monday, December 29th, the candidates' representatives will forward to the local election officials a list of all additional rejected absentee ballots for which both candidates' representatives now agree were wrongfully rejected. At the same time, they shall forward to the local election officials a list of all rejected absentee ballots for which one or more candidates' representative(s) do not agree were wrongfully rejected. Local officials shall use the second list described in this paragraph to prepare materials for county or regional meetings which will occur on December 30, 31 and January 2nd. These materials shall include voter rosters for the precincts in question, absentee ballot applications, absentee ballot envelopes, and additional materials identified in 11 (d).

16. Local election officials must determine if they intend to participate in a regional meeting where candidates' representatives will be allowed to review the rejected absentee ballots in dispute or if they want to hold such a meeting in their own county. A list of regional locations, including a meeting at the Secretary of State's Office on January 2nd, will be announced by close of business on Friday, December 26th. If a local election official agrees to participate in a regional meeting, he or she will bring all envelopes and other materials related to the absentee ballots about which there is disagreement as to whether they were wrongfully rejected to one of several central locations at a prescribed date and time. In addition to the ballot envelopes local elections officials identified, local officials will also bring any additional ballot envelopes related to absentee voters suggested by one or more of the candidates' representatives that they believe have been wrongly rejected, including original applications, envelopes, voter rosters, etc.

17. The individual county meetings and centralized reviews will occur between December 30th and January 2nd. County auditors who intend to hold their own meetings shall designate a date, time and place to process the rejected absentee ballots in question. The date, time and location for the regional meetings shall occur during the same time period and the Secretary of State's Office shall note which jurisdictions' rejected absentee ballots will be reviewed at each regional meeting. Notice must be given to the candidate representatives and the Secretary of State's Office at least 24 hours before any of the meetings are to begin. Local officials who intend to schedule a meeting on Tuesday, December 30th, should notify candidate representatives of the date, time and place of the meeting by close of business on Friday, December 26th, knowing that such a meeting may need to be cancelled depending upon the outcome of negotiations between the candidate representatives and the Office of the Secretary of State over the weekend of December 27th. This meeting must be open to the public.

18. For those ballots where there is disagreement about whether it was rejected in error, the election official will review the voter's absentee ballot application, the absentee ballot envelope, the voter's certificate if it is not printed on the envelope, and the roster to determine whether or not it was rejected for one of the reasons laid out in Minnesota Statutes, sections 203B.12, subd. 2 or, for UOCAVA ballots, 203B.24 and 203B.25. Each candidate's representative may designate two representatives to observe this review and to inspect the absentee ballot envelope, but not the voter roster.

19. If the local election official or representative from any of the campaigns does not agree that the ballot was rejected in error, they must sign a statement to that effect about each ballot, laying out the statutory grounds under which it was properly rejected. After the review, these envelopes will be brought back to the county or city and stored securely with their other election materials

20. All rejected absentee ballot envelopes upon which representatives of both candidates and the local election officials agree were wrongfully rejected shall be forwarded to the Office of the Secretary of State for receipt no later than 11:59 p.m., Friday, January 2nd

21. The county auditor shall store the absentee ballots that all parties agree were wrongly rejected securely until they are transmitted to the Secretary of State, in the secure manner prescribed by the Secretary of State.

22. The Office of the Secretary of State will open, sort and count all of the received ballots in a public setting. As in the recount, campaign representatives may challenge the determination of the Office of the Secretary of State based upon voter intent or identifying marks. Challenged ballots will be brought before the State Canvassing Board for final determination.

23. These votes will be incorporated into the recount totals before the State Canvassing Board certifies the result of the US Senate race and reported to the State Canvassing Board by the Secretary of State for certification by the State Canvassing Board.

You told me today that the Franken Committee's proposal that the two candidates consent to the opening and counting of the approximately 1,350 ballots identified by local officials, without further additions or objections, is not acceptable.

Therefore, the Franken Committee proposes that 85 voters, with respect to which affidavits have been submitted to the counties and to the State Canvassing Board, be added to the local officials' lists. Affidavits or declarations have been submitted with respect to each. We request your agreement that these four voters may have their ballots opened and counted.

- In furtherance of the Supreme Court's Order, the Secretary of State, campaigns and local election officials agreed to a process for reviewing absentee ballot envelopes to determine whether they were wrongfully rejected.
- Prior to the Supreme Court hearing, pursuant to Data Practices Act requests the counties had provided copies of absentee ballot envelopes that were rejected; however, most of the counties did *not* provide copies of absentee ballot applications. As of December 30, no counties have provided any additional application copies to the Coleman campaign.
- The counties forwarded 1,342 names to the campaigns and Secretary of State. The Coleman campaign provided a responsive list by email to the Franken campaign and the Secretary of State on December 28 (approximately 11:00 p.m.) and came to the 10:00 meeting on Monday morning (December 29) ready to go over this list.
- Of this list, the Coleman campaign agreed to 778 envelopes proposed by the counties, requested more information as to 554 envelopes proposed by the counties and requested more information as to 654 envelopes *not* proposed by the counties. The requests for more information were due to county failures to provide copies of absentee ballot applications necessary to confirm that a rejection was indeed improper. It also appeared from the Coleman review of the envelopes provided that different counties were treating similarly-situated envelopes differently (e.g., 35 rejected for mismatch signature in City of Plymouth, while no other jurisdictions had such a significant number rejected for this reason; also, populous counties such as Scott and Carver have very fewer rejected absentees in comparison to similarly-populated counties such as St. Louis, Ramsey, Hennepin). To ensure uniformity of application among the counties, the Coleman campaign requested the counties to provide the absentee ballot applications for review.
- The Franken campaign's only communication was a letter sent by David Lillehaug requesting that the campaigns unilaterally agree to all 1,342 envelopes proposed by the counties, and the Franken campaign's waiver of proposing any additional ballots. This "offer letter" expired by its own terms if the Coleman campaign failed to assent. The Coleman campaign did not respond to this letter.
- At the 10:00 meeting on Monday morning, December 29, the Coleman campaign stated that it agreed that certain envelopes proposed by the counties be opened and indicated that it required additional information (absentee ballot applications, voter registration confirmation) as to the additional envelopes proposed by the counties *and* additional envelopes identified by the Coleman campaign which required further review by the counties and campaigns.
- At the meeting, the Franken campaign orally indicated (without providing a list) that it agreed that all envelopes proposed by the counties be opened (but that no additions be allowed). However, the Franken campaign did not agree to the Coleman proposal that both candidates agree to the ballots which all three (county, Franken, Coleman) had identified as improperly rejected.
- The campaigns and Secretary of State agreed to meet again at 3:00 p.m. that day to further discuss resolution of additional and previously-proposed county recommendation

envelopes. The Coleman campaign forwarded a supplemental list to the Secretary of State and Franken campaign immediately prior to commencement of the meeting.

- The Franken campaign refused to consider any additions and offered to “settle” at 715 county recommendations, together with an additional grouping of 300 other county recommendations by categories within St. Louis, Hennepin and Ramsey Counties (excluding approximately 200 of the prior county recommendations). Hence, the “settlement” conference called for by the Secretary of State and agreed to by the campaigns implied a delay of submitting lists to county election officials until negotiations concluded. Once it appeared that Franken would not agree to any additions and that Coleman would not agree to the abbreviated county recommendations proposed by Franken, Coleman (Tony Trimble) requested Jim Gelbmann (SOS) to forward the Coleman additions list (654) together with the Coleman acceptance list (778) to all local election officials. Gelbmann refused. Trimble then indicated that Coleman would forward (email) to county/city election officials regardless. Hence, the Protocol Rule 15 “deadlines” were obviated by SOS settlement conference agreed to by all parties.
- Neither candidate forwarded such lists required by Rule 15 to local election officials by 3:00 p.m., because the candidates were in the meeting with the Secretary of State and were yet attempting to reach agreement or a resolution. No resolution was reached at the meeting.
- Immediately following the 3:00 meeting (approximately 4:30 p.m. on Monday afternoon), the Coleman campaign forward its list of agreements and disagreements to local election officials.
- At 6:05 p.m. on Monday evening, the Franken campaign (David Lillehaug) sent to the Secretary of State and a list of 85 additional envelopes it wished to review during the regional meetings. It does not appear that this list was forwarded by the Franken campaign to local election officials.

Dear Messrs: Ritchie, Gelbmann and Lillehaug:

Without some immediate remedial action, the process we are now engaged in will yield an invalid and unreliable election result. It is evident from the disparate treatment of the wrongly rejected absentee ballots around the state that any result produced without the consistency that is now sorely lacking will produce the inconsistent counting of these ballots. Our Supreme Court recently tasked each of the Franken and Coleman campaigns, and the Secretary of State and our county/city election officials, to cooperate and avoid such a result. What has happened so far guarantees that we will certainly not achieve the mandated result.

All of us have spent countless hours reviewing in excess of 12,000 absentee ballot envelopes. By Christmas Eve an agreement (the "Protocol") was produced expressly requiring the Franken and Coleman campaigns to submit two (2) cooperatively-prepared lists to the Secretary of State and the county/city election officials: (i) one list specifying absentee ballot envelopes to be opened and counted, and (ii) another list specifying absentee ballot envelopes remaining in dispute. (Section 11 and Section 15 of Protocol). The required lists have not resulted.

Instead, a subtle form of political guerilla warfare has arisen. Confusing and inconsistent directives and demands have confounded our county/city election officials. Differing standards of acceptance and rejection has resulted, and will multiply today and Friday unless changed now. Inconsistent ballot review and counting is the injury suffered by Minnesota and our voters. The blatant and baseless wholesale rejection of ballots for political gain is what we are seeing now, and it is not what we are supposed to be doing under the Supreme Court's order.


Presently, the fates of more than 2,000 votes are at risk and "in play". We should all stop what we're doing and wisely play by the rules we all adopted in order to achieve a valid election result. In order to achieve the consistency demanded by the Supreme Court and deserved by Minnesotans, we propose that: the envelopes and supporting materials for any and all absentee ballots identified by the Franken campaign, the Coleman campaign, the Secretary of State and the county and local election officials be sent to the Secretary of State's office by Friday. At that time, the campaigns and the Secretary of State will review the materials and determine pursuant to the Supreme Court's order which absentee ballots were indeed wrongly rejected. Those ballots will then be counted by the Canvassing Board at its scheduled meeting.

EXHIBIT K

Given the small number of ballots identified, this solution is imminently doable. Without this step to ensure consistency and that all similar ballots are treated the same, the result produced by the Canvassing Board will be invalid and unreliable.

We await your prompt reply for when we can confer and resolve. Thank you.

I have received and reviewed your letter of today. I note your letter does not dispute the existence of material inconsistencies in how similarly situated rejected absentee ballots are being addressed in the process of attempting to fulfill the Supreme Court's mandate. We have proposed a solution to the problem, as set forth in the last paragraph of my letter of this morning, and we urge you again to accept it so that we can advance the goal of treating ballots consistently. If you refuse to do so, the recount tally will not reliably reflect the actual votes of the people of Minnesota.

Because of the urgency of the issue, we plan to file a motion for emergency relief with the Supreme Court. Given all parties' desire to have a consistent and fair process and to see wrongly rejected absentee ballots counted, we would expect you to join us in seeking prompt relief from the Court.

The Coleman campaign would prefer that we resolve the matter among ourselves in the meantime. Please contact me immediately if you are willing to do so.

Dear Tony:

Thank you for your letter concerning the process for counting wrongly rejected absentee ballots.

The change you propose appears to require a change in the Supreme Court order in paragraph two of the modified order in A08-2169, dated December 24, 2008.

It currently says the following:

"the local election officials shall identify for candidates' review those previously rejected absentee ballots envelopes that were not rejected on any of the four bases stated in Minn. Stat. 203B.12 (2006), or in Minn. Stat. 203B.24 (2006) for overseas absentee ballots. Any absentee ballot return envelopes that the local election officials and the candidates agree were rejected in error shall be delivered, unopened and uncounted, to the Minnesota Secretary of State no later than January 2, 2009, along with a notice declaring the number of ballots so delivered."

If you want to propose a specific change in the court order we would circulate this quickly to all parties whose actions are directed by the Supreme Court order in this case.
