CHEST, TWO VIEWS

HISTORY: Hodgkin's lymphoma. -

FINDINGS: PA and lateral radiographs of the chest were performed. Comparison is made with previous chest radiographs of 03-13-09. No other prior comparison studies are currently available.

There has been significant worsening of the mass or lymphadenopathy involving the right lung hilum and the superior mediastinum in the right paratracheal region. There is resultant mild leftward tracheal deviation. Mild perihilar stranding is present in the right lung. The left lung remains clear. No pleural effusions are noted.

A right-sided port-a-cath remains present. Its tip, previously in the region of the SVC/RA (superior vena cava/right atrium) junction, has been slightly pulled back but remains in satisfactory position within the superior vena cava.

Included bony structures appear normal.

IMPRESSION:

1. Significant worsening, since 03-13-09, of right hilar/mediastinal mass or lymphadenopathy.

2. Mild right perihilar lung stranding, most likely representing subsegmental atelectasis.

3. Right sided port-a-cath remains present.
