**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:**

1. Any motions and discovery necessary to litigate any Omnibus Hearing issues shall be served upon counsel and filed with the court no later than April 15, 2008.

2. The party intending to introduce a recorded statement must, at the time the rules require disclosure of the statement, advise the opposing party of the format in which the statement is preserved and must, prior to trial, timely prepare, serve and file a verbatim transcript of the recorded statement. The proponent of the recorded statement is responsible for its accurate transcription. Failure to comply with either requirement may result in exclusion of the recorded statement at trial. A transcript of any audio/video tape intended to be introduced as evidence at either the Omnibus Hearing or trial shall be accompanied by a transcript, to be made available to the Court and opposing counsel prior to the introduction of any of these exhibits.
