Proposed Changes to Code of Judicial Conduct

Canon 4I and Commentary (pages 37-38):

Replace references to sections 3E and 3F with references to 3D and 3E, respectively.

Rules of the Board on Judicial Standards

Rule 5(a)(2) (page 7):

Replace this paragraph with the following:

(2) If at any time the board takes action as may be authorized pursuant to Rule 6(d)(1)(ii), such action shall be a matter of public record.


Rule 6(e)(1) (page 9):

Rule 7(b) (page 12):
