ORDER

WHEREAS, 1999 Laws of Minnesota Chapter 216, authorized the Supreme Court to establish fees for the testing, training, registering of court interpreters;

WHEREAS, the court has reviewed the fee recommendations of the Court Interpreter Program Director;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the following fees shall be assessed for courses in the Court Interpreter Program:

\$25.00 for the Ethics Course and test;

\$50.00 for the Orientation Program;

\$100.00 for each Interpreter Proficiency Preparation Course;

\$75.00 for Phase I of the Interpreter Proficiency Exam;

\$125.00 for Phase II of the Interpreter Proficiency Exam

All fees shall be deposited in a dedicated fund in the State Treasury.


