ORDER

Minnesota Statutes § 480.175, subd. 2 (2000), authorizes the Supreme Court to establish fees for the testing, training, registering of court interpreters.

The court has reviewed the fee recommendations of the Court Interpreter Program Director.

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the following fees shall be assessed for courses in the Court Interpreter Program:

\$50.00 for the Ethics Course and test;

\$200.00 for the Orientation Program;

\$200.00 for each Interpreter Proficiency Preparation Course;

\$150.00 for Phase I of the Interpreter Proficiency Exam;

\$200.00 for Phase II of the Interpreter Proficiency Exam;

\$400.00 for Faculty Development Training

These fees shall be twice the amount indicated for non-Minnesota residents.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT** all fees shall be deposited in a dedicated fund in the State Treasury. The above fees will be effective March 14, 2003.


