ORDER APPOINTING MEMBERS  
TO COURT UNIFICATION STUDY  
COMMISSION

WHEREAS, Laws of Minnesota, 1983, chapter 359, establishes a commission to "study the structure of the state court system to determine the desirability of unifying the current county, municipal, and district courts into a single trial court" and appoints the Chief Justice, or his designee, as a member of said commission and authorizes the Chief Justice to appoint two judges of the district court and two judges of the county or municipal court to membership,

IT IS ORDERED:

That the Honorable John E. Simonett, Associate Justice of the Supreme Court, be, and hereby is, appointed the designee of the Chief Justice on said commission, and


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:
