Dear Mr. Grittner:

I am writing to advise you of a typographical error that exists solely in the layout of forms 9A, 9B and 10 of our Final Report dated October 23, 1992. In the course of converting documents from computer to computer, the indentation of some of the sub-headings was deleted. The correct layout of paragraph 3 of form 9A, paragraph 2 of form 9B and the center paragraph of form 10 is as follows:

  - The marriage does not include minor children and each party has signed a stipulation.
  - The marriage does not include minor children, at least 50 days has elapsed since service of the Summons and petition, and the respondent has not appeared in the action.
