**ORDER FOR PRESENTATIONS AT THE HEARING
TO CONSIDER PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE
GENERAL RULES OF PRACTICE**

In an order filed April 18, 2008, this Court set a hearing in Courtroom 300 of the Minnesota Supreme Court, Minnesota Judicial Center, on July 1, 2008, at 2 p.m., to consider the report and recommendations of the Supreme Court Advisory Committee on the General Rules of Practice concerning cameras in the courtroom. 
IT IS ORDERED:
