IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Honorable Gerald W. Kalina is hereby appointed Chief Judge of said appeal panel.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the compensation of said panel members shall be Fifty and no/100 Dollars (\$50.00) for each half-day they are required to serve.

IT IS ORDERED that the Honorable Kenneth W. Bull be, and hereby is, appointed chief judge of the appeals panel,




