**ORDER**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the provisions of Minnesota Statutes 480.22, the Supreme Court is authorized to designate the location of judges' chambers; and

**WHEREAS**, the Honorable David E. Doyscher of the Tenth Judicial District was granted a disability retirement effective January 31, 2009; and

**WHEREAS**, the Supreme Court has received a request from the Honorable John C. Hoffman of the Tenth Judicial District that his chambers be moved from Anoka in Anoka County to Stillwater in Washington County; and


**WHEREAS**, the Supreme Court has considered the weighted caseload information regarding the relative judicial needs of the Tenth Judicial District and the views of the Tenth Judicial District judges;

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:**

1. The vacancy created by the disability retirement of the Honorable David E. Doyscher be, and hereby is, certified to the Governor to be chambered at Anoka in Anoka County and to be filled in the manner provided by law; and
2. The chambers of the Honorable John C. Hoffman be, and hereby are, moved from Anoka County to Washington County effective upon the assumption of office by the person appointed to fill the vacancy occasioned by the disability retirement of the Honorable David E. Doyscher.
