ORDER

**In Re Judicial Vacancy and Rechambering
Third Judicial District**

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Minnesota Statutes 480.22 the Supreme Court is authorized to designate the location of chambers of judges;

WHEREAS, the Honorable Dennis H. Weber has been granted retirement effective September 1, 1999;


WHEREAS, the Supreme Court has received a request from the Honorable Gerard W. Ring of the Third Judicial District that his chambers be moved from Rochester in Olmsted County to Wabasha in Wabasha County;

WHEREAS, the Supreme Court has considered the weighted caseload information regarding the relative judicial needs of the Third Judicial District and the views of the Third Judicial District judges;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The vacancy created by the Honorable Dennis H. Weber's retirement be and hereby is certified to the Governor to be chambered at Rochester in Olmsted County and to be filled in the manner provided by law; and
2. The chambers of the Honorable Gerard W. Ring be, and hereby are, moved from Olmsted County to Wabasha County effective upon the assumption of office by the person appointed to fill the vacancy occasioned by Judge Weber's retirement.
