IN SUPREME COURT

IT IS ORDERED that the Rules for Discipline and for Reinstatement of Attorneys be amended as follows:

Insert at the beginning of the second paragraph "Except as hereinafter provided,".

Insert between the fourth and fifth paragraphs the following:

"Whenever an attorney is convicted of a felony under Minnesota Statutes the Board of Law Examiners shall forthwith submit to the court a petition for his suspension from the practice of law. Upon a plea of guilty to the commission of such felony, or upon a final affirmance of a conviction of such felony, or expiration of the time for appeal, the Board shall forthwith institute proceedings for disbarment in accordance with these rules.

"Upon final conviction of a felony under Federal Law or the laws of any other state the Board of Law Examiners shall proceed as otherwise provided in these rules."
