PROMULGATION OF AMENDMENTS TO  
THE RULES ON LAWYERS PROFESSIONAL  
RESPONSIBILITY

ORDER

WHEREAS, on June 13, 1996, this Court promulgated amendments to the Rules on Lawyers Professional Responsibility, and

WHEREAS, the Lawyers Professional Responsibility Board has now recommended additional technical amendments to Rules 9(b) and Rule 30, and

WHEREAS, the Supreme Court has reviewed the recommendations and is fully advised in the premises,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Rule 9(b) is ~~repeated~~ amended as follows:

(b) Admission of Charges. The lawyer may, ~~if so desired:~~

~~(1) admit some or all charges; or,~~

~~(2) tender an admission of some or all charges conditioned upon a stated~~

~~disposition.~~

If a lawyer makes such an admission ~~or tender~~, the Director may proceed under Rule

Rule 10(b)

2. Rule 30, Administrative ~~Supervision~~ Suspension is added as follows:

Rule 30, Rules on Lawyers Professional Responsibility Administrative Suspension

3. These amendments shall become effective this date.


