

STATE OF MINNESOTA IN SUPREME COURT No. 81-511

In the Matter of the Redistricting of the County Courts of the First Judicial District ORDER

WHEREAS, the Judicial Planning Committee recommends to the Supreme Court that it redistrict the county courts of the First Judicial District as follows:

District A: Goodhue County

District B: Dakota County

District C: Scott and Carver Counties

District D: LeSueur, McLeod and Sibley Counties

WHEREAS, it is further recommended that the location of chambers of the county court judges within the First Judicial District remain as presently constituted,

WHEREAS, the Supreme Court wishes to allow public testimony on this redistricting plan,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that a hearing on the redistricting plan with respect to the First Judicial District shall be held in the Supreme Court Chambers in the State Capitol, St. Paul, Minnesota, at 9 a.m. on Friday, September 4, 1981.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that until the Supreme Court acts on the above recommended plan, the county court districts comprising the First Judicial District shall remain as presently constituted notwithstanding the memorandum attached to the order of this court dated April 16, 1980, to the contrary. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that advance notice of the hearing be given by the publication of this order once in the Supreme Court edition of FINANCE AND COMMERCE, ST. PAUL LEGAL LEDGER and BENCH AND BAR.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that interested persons show cause, if any they have, why the proposed redistricting plan should not be adopted. All persons desiring to be heard shall file briefs or petitions setting forth their objections, and shall also notify the Clerk of the Supreme Court, in writing, on or before August 28, 1981, of their desire to be heard on the matter. Ten copies of each brief, petition, or letter should be supplied to the Clerk.
