

IF YOU HAVE BEEN CHARGED WITH MORE THAN ONE VIOLATION, CHECK ONLINE (<http://www.mncourts.gov/district/1/?page=188>) OR CALL (651-281-3219) AFTER 7 DAYS TO RECEIVE FINE TOTALS

YOU MUST APPEAR IN COURT AT THE ADDRESS LOCATION NOTED ON THE CITATION IF:

1. You wish to plead not guilty.
2. You wish to plead guilty with an explanation.
3. You have endangered life or property. (Box will be checked on the front of the ticket)
4. The offense you have been charged with is court required.

YOU DO NOT NEED TO APPEAR IN COURT OR CALL THE COURT IF:

1. Your offense is payable by a fine and
2. Your fine is paid prior to your scheduled court appearance.

PLEA OF GUILTY AND WAIVER:

Be advised that the payment of a fine:

1. Is a plea of guilty to the offense charged on the citation
2. Is an admission that you understand and voluntarily waive the following rights:
 - a. To a trial to the Court or by Jury
 - b. To be represented by counsel.
 - c. To be presumed innocent until proven guilty beyond a reasonable doubt.
 - d. To confront and cross-examine all witnesses against you.
 - e. To either remain silent or to testify in your own behalf.

NO PROOF OF INSURANCE VIOLATIONS:

If you have received a citation for No Proof of Insurance and the vehicle you were driving was insured on the date and time of offense, you may show one of the following items to the Court Administrator by the court date on your ticket/citation: Copy of insurance coverage card, letter from agent, or a copy of insurance policy. The information received must include the name of the insured, vehicle type, and proof of coverage for the date of offense. You may provide proof of insurance by fax to 651-438-8265 or by mail or in person at one of the above court locations. **Include a copy of the ticket with your proof of insurance.** If you are charged with another payable violation, send your payment for that violation along with your proof of insurance.

FAILURE TO APPEAR NOTICE:

Failure to pay by or appear on the court date indicated on your ticket will be considered a plea of guilty and waiver of trial for petty misdemeanor offenses and may result in one or more of the following actions being taken against you: Certification of charges to your driving record, DL suspension, Issuance of a bench warrant for your arrest, Seizure of tax refunds and/or referral of your debt to a collection agency
