Bias is negative, hostile, offensive, or insulting behavior directed toward a person for being perceived as different.

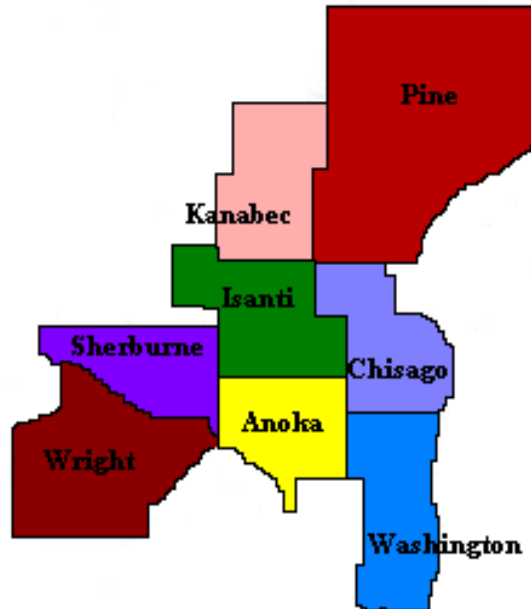

When a complaint is received the committee chair will review the complaint and refer it to the appropriate supervising authority.

The committee also takes efforts to provide ongoing education to members of the court system to address issues that may be presented in complaints and other concerns of bias.
