| Case Type | Description |
|---------------------------|--|
| Annulment | Parties petition the court to end their marriage based on fraud or a misrepresentation. <u>https://www.revisor.mn.gov/statutes/?id=518.05</u> |
| Custody | Parties seeking a custody determination of a minor child. <u>https://www.revisor.mn.gov/statutes/?id=518.156</u> |
| Dissolution with Child | Parties with joint minor children have an irrevocable breakdown of their marriage and are petitioning the court for dissolution. https://www.revisor.mn.gov/statutes/?id=518 |
| Dissolution without Child | Parties with an irrevocable breakdown of the marriage without joint children involved and are petitioning the court for dissolution. https://www.revisor.mn.gov/statutes/?id=518 |
| Family Other | This case type is used for: Orders for Non-Disclosure, Out-of-State Registrations, Grandparent visitation; Qualified Domestic Reations Orders (QDRO) (retirement) cases <u>https://www.revisor.mn.gov/statutes/?id=518</u> |
| Legal Separation | Parties desire to separate and divide assets and liabilities without dissolving the marriage. <u>https://www.revisor.mn.gov/statutes/?id=518</u> |
