Case Type	Description

<b>Dissolution with Child</b>	Parties with joint minor children have an irrevocable breakdown of their marriage and are petitioning the court for dissolution. <a href="https://www.revisor.mn.gov/statutes/?id=518">https://www.revisor.mn.gov/statutes/?id=518</a>
<b>Dissolution without Child</b>	Parties with an irrevocable breakdown of the marriage without joint children involved and are petitioning the court for dissolution. <a href="https://www.revisor.mn.gov/statutes/?id=518">https://www.revisor.mn.gov/statutes/?id=518</a>

<b>Paternity</b>	Parties that need determination of parentage of a minor child.
