**PETITION TO ESTABLISH FINES PAYABLE  
FOR CITY OF DUNDAS CODE VIOLATIONS**

Thomas M. Neuville, the Dundas City Attorney, hereby petitions the court to establish uniform fines payable for the following City of Dundas Code violations. The purpose of this petition is to reduce the number of mandatory court appearances on petty municipal matters and to create a uniform fine for these offenses, thereby reducing the possibility of error in the fine amounts that officers place on their citations. The fines stated below do not include state statutory surcharges





**ORDER**




