The Rules of Practice Before Court Administration for Orders to Show Cause.

The above-entitled matter came on before Court Administration pursuant to a request for an Order to Show Cause hearing. To provide clarification and guidance to counsel and litigants as to this Court's practice preferences, it is hereby ordered as follows:

Order

- 1. Both debtor and creditor shall appear for the Order to Show Cause Hearing.
- 2. A creditor's attorney may be excused from appearing in person if the creditor's attorney must travel in excess of two hours to reach the metro area. If the creditor is excused from appearing in person due to distance, the creditor must be available by telephone at the time of the Order to Show Cause hearing. A creditor may request to appear by telephone due to the distance exception in writing, copied to all other parties.
- 3. If the creditor fails to appear in person (or to be available by telephone based on the distance exception), no bench warrant will issue and the Order to Show Cause will be vacated.
