



Standing Order re Chief Judge's signature on uncontested proceedings under Minn. Stat. §§508.71 and 508A.71

---

Whereas, in Hennepin County, proceedings subsequent to initial registrations under Minn. Stat. §508.71 or §508A.71 are referred to and heard by the examiner of titles or a deputy examiner pursuant to Rules 214 and 208 of the General Rules of Practice for the District Court;

Whereas, such matters are heard every Tuesday afternoon in the examiner's hearing room and, at least three days prior to such hearing all documentary evidence proposed to be used by the petitioner, together with the proposed order, are delivered to the examiner's office by way of Hennepin County's E-File and Serve or otherwise;

Whereas, the examiner or deputy examiner assigned to the calendar reviews all such documents for adequacy, together with the certificate of title, the petition, the examiner's report to the court and all other pertinent matters;

Whereas, if all such documents are adequate and no answer has been filed nor issue raised or appearance made in opposition to the relief sought by petitioner, the examiner or deputy examiner recommends the entry of the order, which is then sent to and signed by the signing judge;

Whereas, approximately 50 such orders are processed each week and the signing judge relies upon the expertise of the examiner and deputy examiner and upon their review of all records and their recommended approval of the order; and

Whereas Rule 14.04(a) of the rules of court permits a judge's signature to be an actual signature that is then scanned into an electronic document format.

NOW, THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED:

That the actual signature, scanned into an electronic document format, of the Chief Judge of the Fourth Judicial District Court may be affixed by a Torrens Deputy Court Administrator on all orders in uncontested proceeding subsequent matters arising under Minn. Stat. §508.71 or §508A.71 bearing the recommendation of the examiner or deputy examiner that the order be entered by the court.

That this standing order is effective as of October 8, 2013 and shall remain in effect until rescinded.
