STANDING ORDER

TO: All police departments located in Hennepin County

Pursuant to this Court's power and discretion under Minnesota Statutes §260B.171, governing juvenile records; and

Consistent with Rule 30.02, subdivision 2(B) of the Minnesota Rules of Juvenile Delinquency Procedure, which allows access to records under juvenile court jurisdiction to the juvenile's attorney, the juvenile's guardian ad litem, and the attorney for the juvenile's parent(s), legal guardian, or legal custodian;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED

All police departments located in Hennepin County shall, upon request and presentation of appropriate identification, provide to any juvenile named in a police report or traffic investigation report a copy of the requested police report or traffic investigation report.

In addition to the named juvenile, other persons entitled to this information under this Order include:


- the juvenile's attorney,
- the juvenile's guardian ad litem, and
- the juvenile's parent(s), guardian, or legal custodian and/or their attorney.

The requested information shall be provided to the aforementioned individuals upon request and presentation of appropriate identification.

This Order does not require the police department to release any information where the police department determines that the release of the requested information could interfere with an on-going police investigation.
