The matter is before the undersigned Chief Judge of the Seventh Judicial District.

WHEREAS, the online parent education classes known as:

- *Children in the Middle*
- *Impact-Based Parent Education*
- *Online Parenting Programs*

have been determined to meet the Minnesota Supreme Court Parenting Education Minimum Standards (M.S. §518.157 subd.1).

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:


1. That utilization of the following an online parenting class as a parent education class alternative in the Seventh Judicial District are authorized:

- *Children in the Middle*
- *Impact-Based Parent Education*
- *Online Parenting Programs*

2. Individual judges of the Seventh Judicial District retain the authority to designate whether a party is required to do an in-person class, or whether they have the option of an online class, and which online classes are approved.

It is the intent of the Order to simply authorize online parenting classes as an option to be utilized by the Seventh Judicial District Bench.
