**In Re: REIMBURSEMENT RATE FOR
ATTORNEY'S FEES AND COSTS
PURSUANT TO MINN. STAT. § 611.27**

WHEREAS, Minn. Stat. § 611.27 requires the chief judge of each judicial district to establish a reimbursement rate for attorney's fees and costs associated with the representation of any defendant in connection with an appeal initiated by the prosecuting attorney of any pretrial order in a criminal proceeding, and

WHEREAS, the fees established shall be paid by the governmental unit responsible for the prosecution,


NOW THEREFORE, after consultation with various city and county attorneys in the Ninth Judicial District, the chief public defender of the Ninth Judicial District, and members of the private bar, the Court makes the following:

ORDER

1. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 611.27, the compensation rate effective October 1, 2014 for attorneys representing defendants in connection with any pretrial appeals initiated by prosecuting attorneys in the Ninth Judicial District shall be \$80.00 per hour plus reimbursement for any necessary costs and expenses reasonably incurred in connection with the pretrial appeal.

2. Compensation shall not exceed a total of \$5,000.00 exclusive of costs and expenses reasonably incurred unless payment in excess of \$5,000.00 is certified by the chief judge of the Ninth Judicial District as necessary to provide fair compensation for services of an unusual character or duration.
