**ORDER FOR HEARING TO CONSIDER
PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
THE RULES OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE**

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that a hearing be held before this court in Courtroom 300 of the Minnesota Supreme Court, Minnesota Judicial Center, on December 12, 2006, at 2:00 p.m., to consider a report filed on September 28, 2006, by the Supreme Court Advisory Committee on Rules of Criminal Procedure, recommending amendments to the Minnesota Rules of Criminal Procedure. 2. All persons desiring to make an oral presentation at the hearing shall file 12 copies of the material to be so presented with the aforesaid Clerk together with 12 copies of a request to make an oral presentation. Such statements and requests shall be filed on or before December 4, 2006.
