BASED ON THE FILE, RECORD, AND PROCEEDINGS, AND BECAUSE:

1. This appeal was filed on October 15, 2007. Appellant specified that no transcript is required.
2. The respondent filed a notice of review and ordered a transcript. We questioned jurisdiction over the notice of review. Respondent has now withdrawn the notice of review.
3. The court reporter certified that the transcript was delivered by mail on November 6. In a postconviction appeal by the defendant, the appellant's brief is due 60 days after filing of the appeal, if no transcript is being prepared, or 60 days after delivery of the transcript. Minn. R. Crim. P. 28.02, subd. 10.

4. We previously granted leave to file an amicus brief in this matter. The brief of an amicus curiae is due seven days after the deadline for the brief of the party with which an amicus curiae is aligned. Minn. R. Civ. App. P. 129.02.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Respondent's notice of review is dismissed.
2. Appellant's brief shall be served and filed by January 8, 2008.
3. The brief of amici curiae shall be served and filed by January 15, 2008.

But if appellant's brief is served early, the brief of amici curiae shall be served and filed within ten days after service of the appellant's brief.
