**ORDER FOR HEARING TO CONSIDER
PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE
RULES OF JUVENILE DELINQUENCY PROCEDURE**

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that a hearing be held before this Court in Courtroom 300 of the Minnesota Supreme Court, Minnesota Judicial Center, on May 23, 2006 at 9:00 a.m., to consider the report of the Supreme Court Juvenile Delinquency Rules Committee, filed on March 20, 2006, recommending amendments to the Rules of Juvenile Delinquency Procedure. A copy of the report is annexed to this order.

1. 2. All persons desiring to make an oral presentation at the hearing shall file 12 copies of the material to be so presented with the Clerk of the Appellate Courts together with 12 copies of a request to make an oral presentation. Such statements and requests shall be filed on or before May 15, 2006.
