

CLIENT SECURITY BOARD VACANCY

The Minnesota Supreme Court invites applications to fill one non-lawyer vacancy on the Client Security Board. The Client Security Board was established by the Minnesota Supreme Court to pay genuine claims against lawyers who have intentionally and dishonestly caused clients to lose money. The seven-member volunteer Board, composed of five lawyers and two non-lawyers, pays the claims with funds collected through annual fees paid by attorneys. This board oversees the distribution of funds

The appointment is for a three-year term, with the possibility of reappointment for a second term.
