

BOARD OF LAW EXAMINERS REPORT TO THE COURT


SUBJECT: Disposal of furnishings of
the presently existing office
at 900 Minnesota Building.

DATE: April 17, 1969

WHEREAS, the State Board of Law Examiners at its meeting of March 28, 1969, resolved that the new offices of the Board at 920 Capitol Square Building should be appropriately furnished and has requested the Court to authorize the necessary expenditures to carry out that purpose, it has become evident that it is necessary to dispose of the furniture with which the present offices at 900 Minnesota Building are equipped.

NOW, THEREFORE, the State Board of Law Examiners recommends and requests that it be authorized by the Court to negotiate for the sale of, and sell, at the best terms available, either by way of trade-in on new furniture or by direct sale, the furniture with which the offices at 900 Minnesota Building are now equipped.


