HEARING ON PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO RULES FOR ADMISSION TO THE BAR

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that a hearing be held before this Court in the Supreme Court, State Capitol Building, Saint Paul, Minnesota, on Thursday, October 4, 1979, at 1:30 p.m. on proposed amendments to the Rules for Admission to the Bar recommended by the State Board of Law Examiners and the State Bar Advisory Council.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that true and correct copies of the Amendments to the Rules for Admission to the Bar be made available upon request to persons who have registered their names with the clerk of this Court for the purposes of receiving such copies and who have paid the specified fee to defray the expense of providing the copies.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that advance notice of the hearing be given by publication of this Order once in the Supreme Court Edition of FINANCE AND COMMERCE, ST. PAUL LEGAL LEDGER, BENCH AND BAR, and the HENNEPIN LAWYER.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that interested persons show cause, if any they have, why the proposed amendments should or should not be adopted. All persons desiring to be heard shall file briefs or petitions setting forth their views and shall also notify the Clerk of the Supreme Court in writing on or before September 27, 1979.
