DOUG, AS ASSISTANT NEWS DIRECTOR, WAS VERY INTERESTED IN OBTAINING FULL MEDIA COVERAGE OF COURT EVENTS. WHILE THESE FORMS MAY NOT INCLUDE MUCH DETAILED

WHILE THESE FORMS MAY NOT INCLUDE MUCH DETAILED INFORMATION, THEY CLEARLY INDICATE THE KIND OF DAILY FRUSTRATION WE ENCOUNTER IN ATTEMPTING TO USE THE TOOLS OF OUR TRADE IN COVERING COURT NEWS IN MINNESOTA.

As a courthouse "beat" reporter myself, I know from the many discussions I have with lawyers and judges that it is virtually impossible under the present system to get full agreement amongst the various parties on any case, no matter how great or small. Somebody will always reject the request.

IT IS AMAZING TO ME THAT WE REMAIN ONE OF THE LAST STATES TO EVEN CONSIDER ALLOWING THE PUBLIC FULL ACCESS TO COURTROOM NEWS. MANY OF OUR NEWSROOM EMPLOYEES FORMERLY WORKED IN WISCONSIN, FLORIDA OR SOME OTHER STATE WITH FULL ELECTRONIC MEDIA ACCESS, AND THEY CAN'T BELIEVE HOW RESTRICTIVE AND UNREALISTIC THE SITUATION IS HERE.

NEEDLESS TO SAY, OUR FRUSTRATION WITH THE PRESENT ATMOSPHERE IS SUCH THAT OUR PEOPLE OFTEN DON T EVEN BOTHER TO ASK PERMISSION BECAUSE EXPERIENCE HAS SHOWN AN ALMOST UNIVERSAL LIKLIHOOD OF DENIAL, SOMETIMES WE HESITATE TO ASK SIMPLY OUT OF CONCERN THE JUDGES WILL THINK THE ONLY CASES WE'RE INTERESTED IN ARE TOO SENSATIONAL. THE WHOLE PROCESS IS QUITE SELF-DEFEATING.
