ORDER EXTENDING EFFECTIVE DATE OF INTERIM RULES OF THE EXPEDITED CHILD SUPPORT PROCESS TO JUNE 30, 2001

WHEREAS, on June 23, 1999, the Court issued an Order promulgating the Interim Rules of the Expedited Child Support Process;

WHEREAS, paragraph 1 of that Order provides that the Interim Rules are effective from July 1, 1999, through June 30, 2000;

WHEREAS, paragraph 5 of that Order directs the Advisory Committee on the Child Support Rules to monitor implementation of the Interim Rules and to submit to the Court by March 1, 2000, its recommendations for revisions;

WHEREAS, the Advisory Committee has requested an extension of time to December 15, 2000, to submit it's final report and recommendations; and

WHEREAS, the Advisory Committee recommends that the final rules to be promulgated by the Court should be effective no sooner than July 1, 2001;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 1. The Advisory Committee on the Child Support Rules shall submit its final report and recommendations by December 15, 2000; and
- 2. The Interim Rules of the Expedited Child Support Process are effective from July 1, 1999, through June 30, 2001.
