Hearing on Proposed Amendments to Rules of Civil Appellate Procedure

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that interested persons show cause, if any they have, why the proposed amendments should not be adopted. All persons desiring to be heard shall file briefs or petitions setting forth their objections, and shall also notify the Clerk of the Supreme Court, in writing, on or before Friday, December 12, 1975, of their desire to be heard on the proposed amendments.
