IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that in accordance with Minn. Stat. § 357.08, as amended in the 1993 Session of the Legislature, the following Rules of Civil Appellate Procedure are amended to reflect increases in filing fees:

- 1. Rule 103.01, subd. 1(d)(4)--notice of appeal filing fee of \$250.
- 2. Rule 105.01--petition for permission to appeal filing fee of <u>\$250</u>.
- 3. Rule 115.03, subd. 3--petition for a writ of certiorari (unless otherwise directed by statute) filing fee of <u>\$250</u>.
- 4. Rule 116.03, subd. 3--petition for writ of certiorari (unless otherwise directed by statute) filing fee of <u>\$250</u>.
- 5. Rule 117, subd. 1--petition for review of a decision of the court of appeals filing fee of <u>\$250</u>.
- 6. Rule 117, subd. 4--conditional petition for review of a decision of the court of appeals filing fee of <u>\$250</u>.
- 7. Rule 120.04--petition for a writ of mandamus or of prohibition filing fee of <u>\$250</u>.
- 8. Rule 121.03--petition for a writ of mandamus or of prohibition in emergency situations filing fee of <u>\$250</u>.

The foregoing increases in fees shall govern all filings on or after July 1,

1993.
