- 3. The advisory task force shall conduct a study of the civil commitment process and make recommendations concerning the following:
  - (1) hearings and procedures governing administration of neuroleptic medications;
  - (2) provisional discharges;
  - (3) monitoring of medication;
  - (4) mental health treatment advance declarations;
  - relationship between the commitment act and the psychopathic personality statute;
  - (6) criteria for commitment and 72-hour holds;
  - (7) time lines and length of commitment;
  - impact of available resources and service delivery systems on commitments and implementation of least restrictive alternatives;
  - (9) training and expertise of professionals involved in the commitment process;
  - separation of functions and conflicts of interest and related due process issues in the commitment process;
  - (11) rights of patients;
  - variations in implementation and interpretation of commitment laws around the state;
  - (13) vulnerable adult reporting and mental competency issues; and
  - any other commitment, legal, and treatment issues identified by the task force.
- 3. Justice Gardebring shall convene the first meeting of the committee.
- 4. The advisory task force shall submit a written report to this Court, the governor and the legislature by January 15, 1996.
