ORDER AMENDING FORM 23 OF THE RULES OF CIVIL PROCEDURE

WHEREAS, Rule 10.01 of the Rules of Civil Procedure requires that every pleading designate the appropriate case type identifier from the subject matter index set forth in Form 23 appended to the rules; and

WHEREAS, four additional civil case type identifiers are necessary to support weighted case load analysis;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that, effective August 1, 1992, Form 23 of the Rules of Civil Procedure is hereby amended as follows (new case type identifiers are <u>underlined</u>):

- 12. Unlawful Detainer
- 13. Wrongful Death
- 14. Other Civil

[All other civil cases not covered by items 1 through 13 above, including but not limited to the following: Appeals From Administrative Agencies Attorney Malpractice Change of Name Corporate Dissolution Declaratory Judgment Discrimination Minor Settlement Mortgage Foreclosure Quiet Title Real Estate Tax Petitions Receivership Torrens Writs of Attachment, Certiorari, Habeas Corpus, Mandamus and Prohibition]
