Order Promulgating Amendments  
to the Rules of Civil Appellate  
Procedure

WHEREAS, by order dated June 17, 1983, the Supreme Court prescribed and promulgated amendments to the Rules of Civil Appellate Procedure and the appendix of forms; and

WHEREAS, by order of that same date, the Supreme Court delayed the implementation of Rules 105, 120, 121, 127 and 131.02 from August 1, 1983 to November 1, 1983, the date of the actual operational establishment of the Court of Appeals; and

WHEREAS, the Supreme Court has determined that additional minor amendments to the Rules of Civil Appellate Procedure were required;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the amended Rules of Civil Appellate Procedure, as prescribed and promulgated on June 17, 1983, and including the subsequent minor amendments, be prescribed and promulgated for the regulation of practice and procedure in civil matters in the appellate courts of the State of Minnesota. The rules which were the subject of the delayed implementation are now fully effective in their amended form.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that these amended rules shall govern all appeals taken on or after August 1, 1983. Appeals and other proceedings pending in the Supreme Court on July 31, 1983, will be governed by the former Rules of Civil Appellate Procedure.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Advisory Committee continue to serve to monitor said rules and amendments and to hear and accept comments for further changes, to be submitted to the Supreme Court when appropriate.
