## CODE OF JUDICIAL CONDUCT

St. Paul. An Advisory Committee established by the Minnesota Supreme Court has scheduled a public hearing to receive testimony on proposed amendments to the standards governing the ethical conduct of judges in the state of Minnesota. The hearing is scheduled for Friday, June 10, 1993, beginning at 9:00 a.m. in room 15 of the State Capitol, St. Paul.
