**APPOINTMENT OF AD HOC ADVISORY
COMMITTEE TO REVIEW THE MINNESOTA
CODE OF JUDICIAL CONDUCT**

ORDER

By order filed on July 19, 2006, the Court ordered that no further amendments to Canon 5 of the Code of Judicial Conduct would be made at that time. In addition, the Court stated that it would appoint an ad hoc advisory committee to study the need for and advisability of further amendments to Canon 5 and other provisions of the Code of Judicial Conduct, with consideration of changes that may be included in the new model code that will be considered by the American Bar Association House of Delegates in February 2007.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. An Ad Hoc Advisory Committee to Review the Minnesota Code of Judicial Conduct is established to review the Code of Judicial Conduct and make recommendations to this Court concerning the need to further amend Canon 5 and other provisions of the code.
