IN RE REPORT CONCERNING PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT AMENDMENT TO THE RULES OF THE MINNESOTA STATE BOARD OF CONTINUING LEGAL EDUCATION.

ORDER

By Order dated December 10, 2003, the Court amended the Rules of the Minnesota State Board of Continuing Legal Education to permit attorneys to attend and receive credit for continuing legal education (CLE) courses related to the professional development of lawyers. The effective date of the Order was February 1, 2004.

The Court ordered the Board of Continuing Legal Education (Board) to monitor the number and type of professional development courses that the Board approves, as well as the credit hours for professional development courses that lawyers report, and submit a report to the Court not later than February 1, 2007.

The Board has requested that the Court grant the Board an extension of time until February 1, 2008, to submit the report in order to allow for analysis of the full three-year reporting period since the adoption of the professional development course credit.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

The Board's deadline for submitting a report to the Court concerning professional development courses is extended until February 1, 2008.
