Minnesota State Board of Continuing Legal Education

Dear Mr. Grittner:

I identified an error in the black-lined version of the rules that was attached to the Board of Continuing Legal Education's Petition for Rule Amendment which filed on September 2, 2009.

The Petition requests that the definitions in Rule 2 be alphabetized. The alphabetization requires additional changes to Rules 5B and 12A. The Board respectfully requests the following additional amendments:

1. Amend Rule 5B(1) to state: "An in-house course as defined in Rule ~~2(M)~~ 2L shall not be approved..."
2. Amend Rule 5B(2) to state: "An in-house course as defined in Rule ~~2(M)~~ 2L that is presented and controlled by an established continuing legal education course sponsor as defined in Rule ~~2(N)~~ 2J, may be approved for credit..."
3. Amend Rule 5B(3) to state: "An in-house course as defined in Rule ~~2(N)~~ 2J, may be approved for credit..."
4. Amend Rule 12A to state: "A lawyer duly admitted to practice in this state may elect restricted status as defined in Rule ~~2(K)~~ 2U by sending a written notice..."
