Minnesota Statutes § 480.175, subd. 2 (2000), authorizes the Supreme Court to establish fees for the testing, training, registering of court interpreters.

The court has reviewed the fee recommendations of the Court Interpreter Program Director.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the following fees shall be assessed for courses in the Court Interpreter Program:

\$50.00 for the Ethics Course and test;

\$200.00 for the Orientation Program;

\$200.00 for each Interpreter Proficiency Preparation Course;

\$150.00 for Phase I of the Interpreter Proficiency Exam;

\$200.00 for Phase II of the Interpreter Proficiency Exam;

\$400.00 for Faculty Development Training

These fees shall be twice the amount indicated for non-Minnesota residents.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT all fees shall be deposited in a dedicated fund in the State Treasury. The above fees will be effective March ________, 2003.
