PROMULGATION OF AMENDMENTS TO ORDER THE RULES OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE

WHEREAS, on November 29, 1990, this Court adopted changes in the Rules of Criminal Procedure; and

WHEREAS, a proposed amendment to Rule 11.04 was inadvertently omitted from the promulgation Order of November 29, 1990,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Rule 11.04 is amended by adding the following sentence at the beginning of the first paragraph of that rule:

"The Omnibus Hearing may include a pretrial dispositional conference to determine whether the case can be resolved without scheduling it for trial."

 This amendment to the Rules of Criminal Procedure shall govern all criminal actions commenced or arrests made after 12 o'clock midnight January 1, 1991.
